About CMAA Foundation Chapter Scholarships

The Construction Management Association of America (CMAA) Houston Chapter awards a limited number of scholarships to qualified students to help them defray the costs of pursuing a degree in Construction Management or a related-degree program. The amounts of the scholarships vary from year to year. For 2019, the local Houston Chapter intends to award one-time scholarships as follows: one (1) \$500 scholarship. Previous recipients may only be awarded one undergraduate and one graduate scholarship.

The CMAA Foundation (nationwide) awards scholarships separately based on the winners of the local chapter program.

Eligibility Criteria

1. Must have completed a minimum of one full academic year of studies, and must have a minimum of one full academic year remaining prior to completing the degree being pursued.
2. Must be enrolled in a Construction Management degree program, or other CM-related degree program from a University located in the Houston Chapter's area (Counties of Brazoria, Chambers, Fort Bend, Galveston, Harris, Liberty, Montgomery, Waller), and show a strong interest in a career in CM, as demonstrated by a response to the essay question in the application package.

NOTE: Incomplete applications will not be considered by the CMAA Houston Chapter Scholarship selection committee. The application and all associated attachments must be submitted via mail.

CMAA Houston Chapter Scholarship Application Process

Complete the scholarship application, making sure to refer to the application directions, and return it to the Houston Chapter by May 31, 2019. The CMAA Houston Chapter will award scholarship recipients at a CMAA Houston Chapter Meeting in July 2019. CMAA Houston Chapter Scholarship Review Process

1. The CMAA Houston Chapter scholarship selection committee will review all complete applications received from direct submittals, and make its decision based on the received application. Student's enrollment status will be verified by CMAA Houston prior to the award of all scholarships. Selected winners will be notified on or about Jun 30, 2019.
2. Scholarship checks will be presented as part of the CMAA Houston July Chapter Meeting Program. For students that are unable to attend, checks will be mailed directly to the student's provided address.

CMAA Houston Chapter Scholarship Selection Criteria

The CMAA Houston Chapter scholarship selection committee will consider the following in selecting winners of the chapter scholarships:

- academic performance: 40%
- quality of essay on future plans and scholarship interest: 20%
- recommendation of faculty advisor: 15%
- extracurricular activities: 25%



Scholarship Application Checklist

To be considered for a CMAA Houston Chapter scholarship, you must complete the following checklist and include it with the application submission.

- Completed **all** sections of the application packet, including:
 - General Information
 - Academic Information, including Current Academic Schedule
 - Included a transcript (scanned copy) from each school attended for undergraduate and/or graduate credit.
 - Extracurricular Activities
 - Employment (If applicable)
 - One Essay on Future Plans and Scholarship Interest
- CMAA Student Chapter/Regional Chapter Membership Verification (If applicable)
- Distributed the evaluation/recommendation form to your academic or faculty advisor and let your advisor know the completed form and one-page statement must be submitted directly to the CMAA Houston Chapter using below address by May 31, 2019.
- Proofed the spelling, grammar, and the presentation of the application.
- Signed and dated the application package.
- Made a copy of the completed application package.
